## 16.39.6.9 RENEWAL REQUIREMENTS: A license issued pursuant to this section shall not be renewed unless the license holder satisfies the requirements for the issuance and for the renewal of a license pursuant to Chapter 61, Article 23 NMSA 1978. The licensee must submit the following documents at the time of renewal: applicants, with board approved engineering/surveying degrees shall submit their official transcript(s) provided directly from the university; (2) applicants with an accreditation board for engineering and technology (ABET) accredited engineering technology degree shall submit their official transcript(s) provided directly from the university; acceptable replies from five (5) references, pursuant to Section 61-23-10 (B) NMSA <del>1978.</del> Every license shall automatically expire if not renewed on or before December 31 of the applicable biennial period pursuant Section 61 23 10 (B) NMSA 1978.] A license issued pursuant to this section shall not be renewed unless the license holder satisfies the requirements for the issuance and for the renewal of a license pursuant to Chapter 61, Article 23 NMSA 1978. The licensee must submit the following documents at the time of renewal: Proof of military service, spouse or dependent, or veteran status: (a) for military service member: copy of military orders; **(b)** for spouse of military service members: copy of spouse's military orders, and copy of marriage license; (c) for spouses of deceased military service members: copy of spouse's DD214 and copy of marriage license; for dependent children of military service members: copy of military orders (d) listing dependent child, or a copy of military orders and one of the following: copy of birth certificate, military service member's federal tax return or other governmental or judicial documentation establishing dependency; for veterans (retired or separated): copy of DD214 showing proof of honorable (e) discharge. applicants for professional engineering license must meet the requirement as outlined in **(2)** 16.39.3.9 NMAC; applicants for professional surveying license must meet the requirement as outlined in 16.39.5.8 NMAC.
