PERSONNEL

The agency has 8 vacancies out of 35 positions, which places our vacancy rate at 23% percent.

BUDGET

FY26 Budget

As of February 11, 2026, our general fund balance in the 200 category was \$1,429,113; the balance in the 300 category was \$6,601; and the 400 category balance was \$31,354.

DIVISION HIGHLIGHTS

ALD

During the second quarter of FY26, all rule updates to the *New Mexico Administrative Code* were published within 30 days. The rules were available online an average of 9 days after the effective date. In addition, 151 rulemaking actions, 53 notices of rulemaking were filed and published by the established deadlines. The ALD also provided 2 large group trainings, as well as 29 individual trainings.

RMD

During the second quarter of FY26, the RMD provided 7 virtual records management and information trainings to 192 public employees. The division pulled and processed 357 boxes within 24 business hours. Also, 3,139 units of public records that met their legal retention were validated and processed. There were requests for destruction for 24 electronic records, and 3,115 boxes.

ITMD

In the second quarter, ITMD continued updating the SRCA website with current information and assisted the public in resolving site access issues. The division also responded to approximately 42 helpdesk requests within a 2-hour timeframe. In addition, the division hired a new IT end user support person to provide support to staff.

SANM

During the second quarter of FY26, SANM entered 5,728 descriptive records into HERITAGE. Included were records pertaining to driving while intoxicated and domestic violence cases in the Bernalillo Metropolitan Court Records (Collection No. 1999-029). In addition, SANM conducted FY26 Archives Month event titled "Archival Oddities: Misfits and Mysteries in Collections", in which 13 repositories participated.

OSH

The state historian attended 1 Cultural Properties Review Committee meetings and 1 Historic Marker Committee meetings in the second quarter of FY26. OSH also received 198 research inquiries. All received responses within 2 business days and were provided full responses within 14 business days. The OSH staff also provided 7 educational, research, preservation, and outreach activities.
