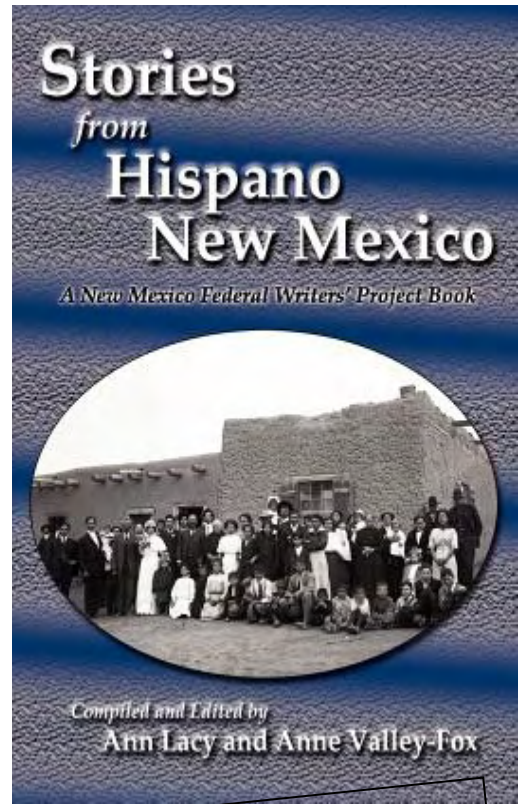

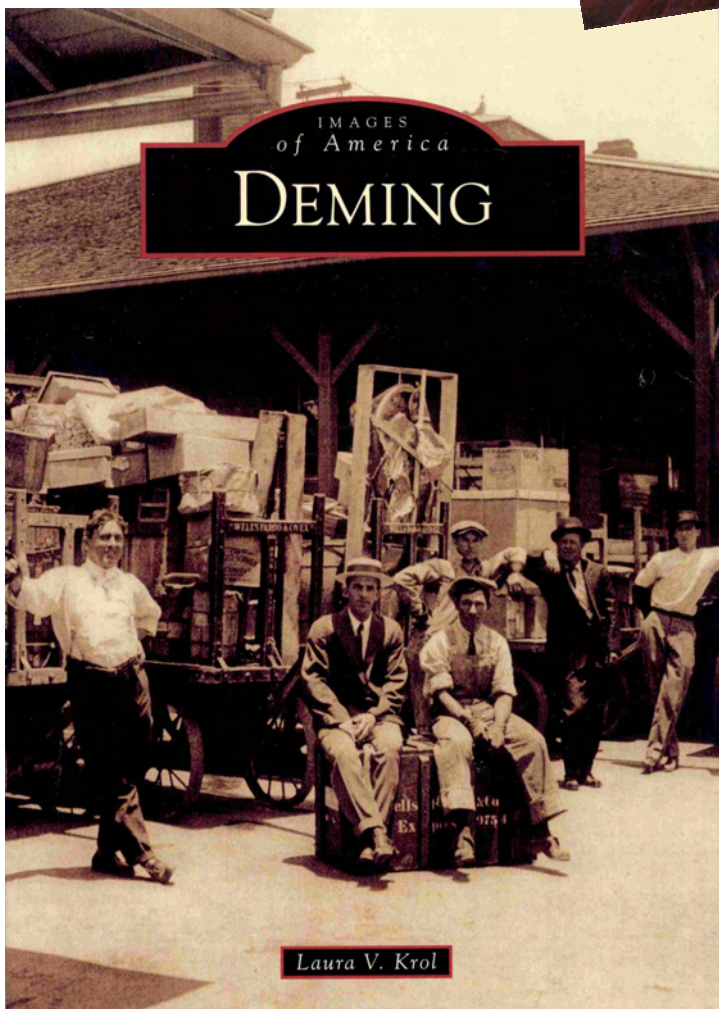
**Christine Barber**

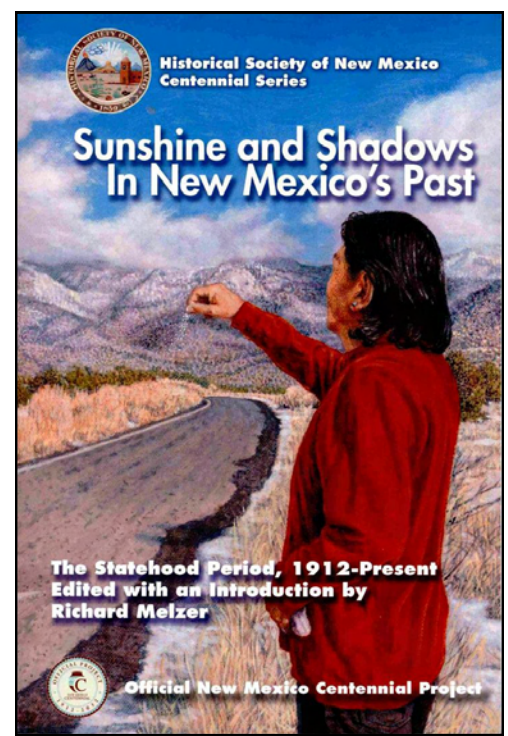
**Ann Lacy & Anne Valley-Fox**
